The assessment of the instructor group proficiency badges should follow the below procedures, except the Sailor (Interest) proficiency badge:

- Obtain the relevant proficiency badge for at least three months before applying for the assessment of the corresponding badge in the Instructor group.
- Understand the assessment requirements and training methods for obtaining the relevant proficiency badge which enable the Scout to instruct other Scout members.
- 3. Instruct at least one Scout member and assist them to obtain the corresponding badge within appropriate time (usually three months). The Scout members being instructed can be assigned by the assessor or nominated by the Scout being assessed with assessor's consent. (Note: Scout members could meet the above requirements by assisting in training courses in order to complete the assessment of Instructor group proficiency badge.)

Sailor (Instructor) proficiency badge has the following requirements: Sailor

- 1. Obtained the Sailor (Pursuit) proficiency badge for at least three months.
- 2. Instruct one or a group of Scout members to obtain Sailor (Interest) proficiency badge under the supervision of a sailing instructor recognised by the Association.

Note: (1) A sailing instructor recognised by the Association must be present to supervise during instruction.

(2) The requirements of this proficiency badge are subject to the latest changes made by the relevant association.
