 - (d) Environmental Protection Ambassador Scheme or Environmental Protection Seminar/Workshop
 - (e) Life Education Seminar/Workshop
 - (f) Prevention of Drug Abuse or Drug Education Seminar/Workshop
 - (g) Fire Safety Ambassador Scheme or Fire Safety Seminar/Workshop
 - (h) Equal Opportunities Education Seminar/Workshop
 - (i) Aids Prevention Education Seminar/Workshop
