Complete the following:

- 1. Understand the usage of the following items in a map of scale 1:20,000: Scale, coordinates, true north, grid north, magnetic north, contour lines
- 2. Understand the basic traffic signs shown on a traffic map.
- 3. Prepare a road map of a 80 kilometres route assigned by the assessor and suitable for a car or motorcycle driver to use.
- 4. 4. Act as a navigator in a 100 kilometres trip sitting next to the driver.
 - Note: (1) At least half of the trip should be driving away from the highways, and not more than 32 kilometres of the trip are using the car lanes.
 - (2) Motorcycles or other transportation means are acceptable upon the assessor's approval.
- 5. Participate in an organized orienteering event.



Completion of this Badge, including a total of six months or above in lecture or practicum, would be counted as an equivalent of relevant item under Skills Section of the Hong Kong Award for Young People Bronze Award.
