Complete the following:

1. Familiar with the water safety rules. Understand the dangers of wading, the precautions to be taken and the meaning of a dangerous fishing ground / spot.
2. Go fishing in freshwater (reservoir area) or salt water at least three times within three months. In each of these fishing trips, keep a record of the species, amount, sizes of fish caught, fishing location, method, fishing equipment and bait used, weather conditions, tide and current conditions, and describe the effects of these conditions on respective fishing trips.
3. Able to identify at least ten fish species: six in saltwater and four in freshwater.
4. Have a thorough understanding of the habit of the above 10 fish species and other relevant knowledge such as fishing period, living habitat, fishing methods and suitable baits, etc.
5. Know how to use different types of baits, feather baits and the floats, buoys and sinkers used in still fishing.
6. Know different types of hooks and respective basic knots used. Understand how to use different fishing tools and their maintenance methods.



Completion of this Badge, including a total of six months or above in lecture or practicum, would be counted as an equivalent of relevant item under Skills Section of the Hong Kong Award for Young People Bronze Award.
