Complete the following:

- Choose one from the following items and observe how wildlife grows in any two seasons of the year, with a total of not less than four observations (suggest to conduct approx. once a month). Explain to the assessor the results of the observations using notes, drawings, photos and sketches.
 - a piece of woodland
 - a piece of parkland
 - a piece of grassland
 - a piece of moorland
 - a piece of wetland
 - a piece of seashore, sand dune or rocks
 - a length of hedgerow
 - a length of roadside vegetation
 - a length of stream or river
 - a small pond

- Discuss with the assessor how human activities or management at the area of study can affect the growth of wildlife, e.g. replacing deciduous trees with conifers, waste oil discharged by oil tankers in the sea and cutting hedges and roadside vegetation by machine instead of manpower, etc.
- Choose a plant or animal species (E.g. ferns or herbaceous plants, wildflowers, trees and bushes, butterflies, moths, dragonflies, damselflies or other insects, amphibians, beasts, birds, fishes, etc.) and discuss with the assessor the results of observations and studies and the source of information, such as museums or books, etc.
