Complete either (A) or (B):

(A) Complete the “Basic Expedition Course” organized by the Association.

(B) Complete the following:

1. Acquire the Map Reader Badge;
2. Understand the following basic skills for exploring the countryside:
  - (a) Familiar with the gears and equipments;
  - (b) Planning and drafting the written plan;
  - (c) Planning for the task during the trip;
  - (d) Camping skills;
  - (e) Food and cooking skills;
  - (f) Mountaineering skills;
  - (g) Code of Outdoor Activities;
  - (h) First aid knowledge and safety measures;
  - (i) Understanding the weather;
  - (j) Safety of the countryside trip and how to handle accidents; and
  - (k) Preparation skills of a written report.
3. Complete a two-day-one-night countryside trip <sup>[1]</sup>, the distance of which should not be less than 20 kilometres. The trip should be an exploration trip in an unfamiliar countryside and complete a task during the trip.

Note: (1) The trip must be on foot.
