1. General knowledge
 - (a) Know the activities of Extension Scouts.
 - (b) Know the categories and special characteristics the following people suffer from:
 - (i) Mental disability
 - (ii) Hearing impairment/deafness
 - (iii) Visual impairment/blindness
 - (iv) Physical disability
 - (v) Autism
2. Services
 - (a) Take part in two activities with the disabled and report briefly to the assessor the experience. Describe matters requiring particular attention and how to obtain further resources if similar service is to be conducted again. The Scout can participate in the activities individually or in a group.
 - (b) Survey a site such the Group headquarters, a school or a campsite and suggest to the assessor facilities that are suitable for the disabled and make recommendations for improvements.
 - (c) Talk to a disabled person or read an article about a disabled person. Discuss with the assessor how that person overcame his difficulties and the enlightenment it brings to the Scout and others.
